Tailor Book and Italic

This is Tailor, yet another new font from Suomi Type Foundry, with some Open-Type features: st goes st, same goes with ct and rt, and fi and fl are accompanied by ffi and ffl. And did you notice those first two letters?

Tailor is a single weight font with true italics, and those italics have a stylistic set for alternate p,v,w, k and y. They go p, v, w, k and y. (and ky and kg.)

Tailor also has numerals both tabular lining, and proportional old style: 0123456789 goes 0123456789.

And www goes www, www, and www to save those unwanted counterspaces. Tailor has a friendly feel to it with those

rouded corners and chubby characters. It is primarily designed for headline use, but as you can see here, it can also handle longer strings of text.

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
